



## SUPERVISION AGREEMENT

### Between doctoral students and supervisors in the Department of Physics

In accordance with § 6 paragraph 6 of the Doctoral Degree Regulations of the Faculty for Mathematics, Informatics and Natural Sciences

Doctoral students and supervisors will conclude this supervision agreement in order to ensure a high quality of academic education as well as the best possible supervision and support for the doctoral students. In addition, this supervision agreement specifies the rights and duties of the persons involved.

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The doctoral student commits herself or himself to:

- Design and establish the doctoral project so that the doctoral degree can normally be accomplished within three years.
- Take an active part in seminars of the work group on a regular basis as well as to present her or his work progress at least once a year.
- Write the dissertation and present the oral doctorate defense (disputation) either in German or English.
- Regularly inform the co-supervisor of the Department of Physics of the progress made on the doctoral project, in case the supervisor is not a member of the Department of Physics.  
This is accomplished by providing
  - semi-annual reports.
  - reports in seminars of the work group of the co-supervisor.
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The supervisors commit themselves to:

- Adjust the topic and goals of the research project so that the doctoral degree can be accomplished within three years.
- Monitor the planned level-according progress and the process of the doctoral project periodically.
- Support the attendance of subject-related events (conferences, meetings, workshops).
